 - Printers & Fax Machines
 - Cables & Cords
 - Cell Phone Batteries
 - Laptop Batteries
 - Laptop Computers
 - UPS Battery Backups
 - Toner Cartridges
 - Ink Cartridges
 - Audio Visual Equipment
 - Telephones & Cell Phones**
 - DVD Players & VCRs
 - Gaming Systems
 - String Christmas Lights
 - Microwaves
 - Small Appliances
 - Metal Items
 - Water Heaters
 - Exercise Equipment
 - Car Batteries (sealed lead acid)
 - Metal Bed Frames
 - Metal Rain Spouting
 - Filing Cabinets

- Additional items that can be recycled for a fee, on Recycling Days, include:
- Washers & Dryers – \$20
 - Stoves – \$20
 - Dishwashers – \$20
 - Computer Monitors – \$20
 - Televisions under 42" (CRT or Flat Screen) – \$40
 - TVs (in wooden console, Projection, Over 42", TV Tubes, or Broken Screen TV) – \$60
 - Air Conditioners & Dehumidifiers – \$25
 - Refrigerators – \$35
 - Floor Freezers – \$35
 - Floor Copiers – \$20
 - Console Stereos (in cabinet) – \$35
 - Water Coolers or Dorm Refrigerators – \$25

Destruction Services for a Fee

- Document Destruction (offsite) – \$10* per standard paper size box
- Hard Drive Destruction (offsite) – \$10* per drive **Includes a Certificate of Destruction*

Per the Covered Device Recycling Act, **Borough Refuse Collection** can no longer accept TVs, desktop or notebook computers, monitors, keyboards, printers or any other device sold exclusively for external use with a computer that provides input into or output from the computer. **Electronics Recycling Days are the perfect opportunity to safely and properly recycle these items!**
